

TOWN OF DILLSBORO

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PROPERTY
NUMBERING SYSTEM**

ARTICLE I

Section 1.1 Statutory Authorization

The legislature of the State of North Carolina has in Article 8 of Chapter 160A, Section 174 authorized local governments to adopt ordinances that will promote the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens.

Section 1.2 Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this ordinance is to require all residences and places of business to post the Jackson County 911 street numbers that are intended to aid in delivery of parcels, assist emergency medical, fire and police departments in responding to calls, and to generally facilitate social and business activity throughout town.

ARTICLE ii

ADOPTION AND POSTING OF NUMBERS

Section 2.1 Adoption and Numbering Plan

The property numbering plan for the Town of Dillsboro shall be based on the Jackson County 911 code system and is hereby adopted as the official property

numbering system for the Town of Dillsboro.

Section 2.2 Posting of Numbers

- 1. All residences and business buildings shall post in a highly visible location on the building or a post no more than twenty-five feet from the front paved street or road that number assigned by the Jackson county 911 code.**
- 2. Numbers indicating the property number shall be a minimum of three inches in height and shall not exceed eight inches in height.**

ARTICLE III

EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance is effective upon adoption.
